How to position your mast coat

The final positioning of the mast coat should be done when the mast is stepped in the boat.

Tools needed:

Pencil

Sharp knife or a pair of scissors

Assembly

- 1. Slide the mast coat into position, so that it stands on the deck ring.
- 2. Draw a line around the mast at the top edge of the mast coat (fig 1.)
- 3. Push the mast coat away from the line (upwards or downwards).

4. Place rubber tape 530-471 with it's upper edge on the pencil line, (fig 2.) Start at the front of the mast and work round to the front again.

- 5. Cut the tape so that the ends overlap by approximately 10 mm. (fig 3.)
- 6. Pull the mast coat gently into place over the tape. A screw driver or similar tool may be use as a shoehorn.
- 7. Fit the clip over the mast coat and tighten it hard.
- 8. Fit the large clip around the deck ring.
